The Program

Leadership Sandoval County is offered one full day monthly, October through June, beginning with a two day retreat in September, and is limited to thirty participants per year to maximize the personalized experience. Each session focuses on not only the topic of the day, but serves to enhance leadership skills, promote camaraderie and build life-time relationships among participants.

Throughout the course of the program, you will be informed of the issues, problems and projects that affect your community such as:

- ✓ *Leadership styles and strategies*
- ✓ *Community Image Building & Diversity*
- ✓ *Economic development*
- ✓ *City/County/State government*
- ✓ *Health and human services*
- ✓ *Education*
- ✓ *Tourism*

Additionally, all participants work together on a community-oriented group project that will require meetings outside of the regular class days.

The Selection

Completed applications are due no later than August 8th to the Rio Rancho Regional Chamber. Through an interview process, class members will be chosen by a selection panel comprised of Alumni, community leaders and business professionals. The Commitment

Classes meet from September through June. It is important to realize that a time commitment is required, as graduation is based on attendance at all class sessions (only one absence is allowed).

The Tuition

Program tuition is \$700.00 and covers all materials, bus tours, and food at all class sessions. Future RRRCC members tuition is \$800.00.
