Mayor Swisstack's Transition Team  
Infrastructure Team Meeting  
Monday, April 21, 2008

Lawrence Rael opened the meeting. Six of the eight team members were present. Four residents attended.

Discussion centered on the Team's recommendations for the Final Report. Growth and a Growth Plan were determined to be the most important elements of the report. Also, corridor plans and master plans for communities around the city should somehow be integrated into the city's overall plan for growth.

Transportation was also felt to be part of the recommendations. Specifically the lack of funding for appropriate infrastructure needs; including maintenance. Public transportation should also be considered as part of the recommendations.

Water resource management will also be part of the final recommendations. It's important that the city have an aggressive resource management plan in addition to purchasing water rights.

Communication within the city and with residents is lacking and needs to be improved. Annual reports were suggested as a possible solution.
